All employees whether direct or sub-contract must refer to the safety policy provided by this company and be aware that they have both a moral responsibility and a legal duty not only to work in a safe manner but also to co-operate in efforts to create a safe and healthy environment in which to complete each project.

It is the policy of Select Demolition Ltd that at each working location the Site Manager is responsible for implementing the Company Safety Policy. Every employee should be fully aware of the need to comply with all matters pertaining to health and safety both as individuals and in respect of the health and safety of their fellow workers.
